PRAYING THROUGH THE NAMES OF GOD

BACKGROUND

What better word than "rock" to represent God's permanence, protection, and enduring faithfulness?

When you pray to the Lord your Rock, you are praying to the God who can always be counted on. His purposes and plans remain firm throughout history.

The New Testament identifies Jesus as the spiritual rock that accompanied the Israelites during their long journey through the desert. He is also the stone the builders rejected but that has become the cornerstone of God's church.

Rocks provided shade, shelter, and safety in the wilderness and were used to construct altars, temples, houses, and city walls. Heaps of stones were also used to commemorate important events in Israel's history.

God's commandments, given to Moses, were etched on stone so that all generations would learn his law.

The word "rock" epitomizes his enduring faithfulness.

The Hebrew noun tsur is often translated "rock" or "stone," while petra is the Greek word for rock.

To worship Yahweh Tsuri (yah-WEH tsu-REE) is to echo Hannah's great prayer of praise: "There is no Rock like our God" (1 Samuel 2: 2).

SCRIPTURE

"The LORD lives, and blessed be my rock; And exalted be God, the rock [El Sali] of my salvation. 2 SAMUEL 22: 47

"He [David] said:

"The LORD is my rock, my fortress and my deliverer, my God is my rock, in whom I take refuge, my shield and the horn of my salvation. He is my stronghold, my refuge and my saviour— from violent men you save me. I call to the LORD, who is worthy of praise, and I am saved from my enemies."

(2 Samuel 22: 2- 4)

"Those who trust in the LORD are like Mount Zion, which cannot be shaken but endures forever. As the mountains surround Jerusalem, so the LORD surrounds his people both now and forevermore." (Psalm 125: 1- 2)

"Praise be to the LORD my Rock, who trains my hands for war my fingers for battle. He is my loving God and my fortress, my stronghold and my deliverer.... Reach down vour hand from on high; deliver me and rescue me from the mighty waters, from the hands of foreigners whose mouths are full of lies, whose right hands are deceitful. I will sing a new song to you, O God; on the ten-stringed lyre I will make music to you, to the One who gives victory to kings, who delivers his servant David from the deadly sword." (Psalm 144: 1-2, 7-10)

"You will keep in perfect peace him whose mind is steadfast, because he trusts in you. Trust in the Lord forever, for the LORD, the LORD, is the Rock eternal." (Isaiah 26:3–4) What are you facing today that frightens you or shakes your confidence? Illness? Job loss? Trouble at home? Difficulties at work? No matter how out of control life may seem, decide to keep your eyes glued to Jesus— to his character and his faithfulness and not to the circumstances that disturb you.

Recommit yourself not only to hearing his Word but to building your life on it, confident that when the rains come down, the streams rise up, and the winds blow and beat against your house, it will not fall because its foundation is securely built on the rock.

Perfect peace, rest, unshakable faith, salvation—these enduring promises belong to all who trust in God. These blessings come, not by wishing but by willing, by deciding to sink our roots into God, spending time in prayer, reading his Word, holding fast to his commandments, and yielding to his Spirit at work within us.

Scripture tells us we are to live and move and have our being in the God who made us. When tragedy comes, as it inevitably will, and when the world around us begins to tremble and shake, as it inevitably will, we will not be shaken. Instead, the Lord who is the Rock eternal will be there, giving us rest and peace.

Lord, you are more reliable than the ground I stand on and your faithfulness is more than I can comprehend.

Thank you for hearing my voice and rescuing me when I cry to you. When I am shaken, you steady me. When I am in trouble, you save me.

You are a sure and steady rock that my feet will not slip off, and my hands will cling to.

I have a solid footing in You, safe from the sinking sand, mire and clay all around me.

You are a solid, immoveable, unbreakable, reliable Rock!
